
This is an inflection point—this can be our moment to create the change we need and come together for a brighter future. It will take stick-to-itiveness, tenacity and perseverance.

In 1997, I worked in the US EPA's Policy office during the Kyoto Protocol climate negotiations. I have now worked over half my life on climate change—the biggest social justice issue of our lifetimes. I feel hope about climate action, even on the days where I question my resolve.

After the People's Climate March in New York City in 2014, I received a white rock at the Cathedral of St. John the Divine and

it now sits on my living room mantle. It's a reminder of my grounded commitment to this work, of how much has happened and how much more needs to happen—an ever-present symbol for needed action. In honor of my family who live in my birthplace of India, and my young nieces who live close by, I am going to do whatever I can to stop the climate crisis from getting worse.

We are making progress—but we need to move much faster to take on the fossil fuel industry. It really is “the fierce urgency of now.” Thank YOU for supporting Climate Solutions.




Total income - \$3,517,416
